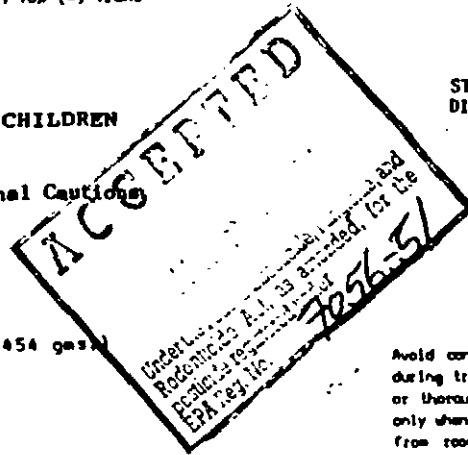

Remove protective cap. Hold container upright and point valve in desired direction and press button to spray.

FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND WASPS: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FOR CRABLING INSECTS: Roaches, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Saw Flaps, Spiders and Centipedes: spray thoroughly into hiding places. Spray into cracks, crevices, moist areas, under refrigerators, baseboards, storage areas, and into openings around sinks and pipes. Spray directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nest and point of entry. Spray on ants when possible. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.
DISPOSAL: Wrap container and dispose of in trash.
Do not incinerate.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Avoid contamination of food and food stuffs. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. In hospitals patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Cover or remove fish bowls. Remove all pets from area to be treated.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial if indicated.
