DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove protective cap. Point spout type nozzle toward nest, crevice or hole where infestation or insects are known to be inside. Press center of valve top all the way down and spray area until saturated with insecticide. User should always use the product with the wind at the user's back.

If insects reinfest their nest at a later date retreat as described above.

Use only out of doors.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Contact with skin, eyes, or clothing should be avoided. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately.

On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. See physician if irritation persists.
