STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

HAZARDS TO HUMAN & DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas apply only when the plants are in operation. Shake well before re-use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray approximately 180 degrees. Pull trigger to spray. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

FOR USE IN HOUSEHOLDS AND INDUSTRIAL PLANTS

**KILLS FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS:** Close all doors and windows. Turn off lights. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially corners and other light sources which attract these insects. Turn the room with mist. Then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**KILLS WASPS AND HORNETS:** Space spray - Before applying, close all doors, windows and ventillator openings. In unfinished attics and crawl spaces where direct sprays cannot reach pests, point nozzle upward and fill the area with mist at the rate of 35 seconds per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Leave treated area immediately after application is complete. Closing off area for at least 1/2 hour. Ventilate area when treatment is complete. Repeat as necessary.

**KILLS CRAWLING INSECTS:** Roaches, earwigs, grass mites, sawbugs, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and walls, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible as a contact spray. Repeat applications as necessary.

**KILLS ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS - REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS AROUND PICNIC AND RECREATIONAL AREAS, HOMES AND INDUSTRIAL PLANTS.

Kill mosquitoes, gnats (midges), house flies, horse flies, deer flies and flying beetles (millers) by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

**KILLS NUISANCE PESTS - ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS: WASPS AND HORNETS:** Direct spray. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into living and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on spray traps that enter buildings.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**SPIDERS:** Direct short burst of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

**EARWIGS:** Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and other hiding places on outdoor porches, patio floor and doorway entrances. Repeat as necessary.

**IMPORTANT -** Sweep up all dead insects and deposit these sweepings into a closed garbage container within two hours after each treatment.
