

CSA INDOOR/OUTDOOR INSECT SPRAY

For Household And Industrial Use

OUTDOORS — TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS: Kill mosquitoes, gnats (midges), houseflies, horse flies, deer flies, and flying moths (moths) by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and patios in similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS — TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: Kills aphids, exposed thrips, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles on smaller azaleas, dendrons, pines, spruce, hemlock, spruce, dogwood, palm, mimosa, soyan, viburnum, euonymus, oaks, maples, locust, Forsythia and weigela. Kills mimosa webworm larvae on mimosa. Spray directly on insects. Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, whiteflies and Japanese beetles on geraniums, gins, annual snapdragons, carnations, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, daisies, geraniums, marigolds, daphne, lantana, myrobalan, Queen's lace, broad leaf acacia.

Hold container 18 inches from the treated plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds or spray at the rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

USE WITH CAUTION on evergreens, junipers, roses, in budding hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use. For adult whiteflies and two-spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at two day intervals if necessary.

PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS: Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites on African violets, philodendrons, geraniums, begonias, coleus. Spray as directed above. Leave the sprayed area when gone indoors and ventilate area after treatment is completed.

TO KILL NUISANCE PESTS — ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS:
WASPS: Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray outdoors where possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS: Direct short burst of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

EARWIGS: Spray directly on earwigs in cracks and crevices, around pipes, in corners and other outdoor areas. Repeat as necessary.

Houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, roaches, earwigs, two-spotted mites, sowbugs, spiders, centipedes, ants, horse flies, deer flies, aphids (plant lice), leafhoppers, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, plant bugs, Japanese beetles, spittlebugs.

CAUTION

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not freeze. Empty container. Wrap container and label intact. Collect. Never throw containers into fire. Do not drink.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake well before each use. Hold can 18 to 24 inches from spray opening away from persons, pets, animals and plants.

HOUSEHOLD PEST: TO KILL HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS: Hold container 18 to 24 inches from the room, especially windows and other openings which attract these insects. Spray the room walls and ceiling. Then move the treated areas. Keep them closed up for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when insect control is complete.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS: BIRDS, SPIDERS, GRAMMIES, SOWBUGS, BEES AND BEEFLETS: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, moist areas, openings around doors and under refrigerators, baseboards, and other furniture. Spray directly on insects where possible.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANIMAL PEST: TO KILL FLEAS — DOGS, CATS:

Apply directly to animal skin and hair. Do not spray in the eyes or other areas where insect contact may occur. Do not allow to contact skin and eyes. Do not spray on bare skin. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from the ears or mouth of animal. To reduce chance of insect getting away. Treat the areas of the animal's body where fleas are found. If animal is very active, spray on the animal's body and let it stand for 15 minutes. If animal is not active, spray on the animal's body and let it stand for 15 minutes. Pet hair is not affected.
