After application, exit and keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room thoroughly after re-entry. Dispose of dead insects. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, AND CRICKETS: Spray as many insects as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room infested with these parts. Pay special attention to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these parts are suspected of hiding. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Treet doors, around window frames, ant traits, and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Thoroughly spray top and bottom of rugs and carpets. Treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOT. ED GRAIN BEETLES, AND RICE WEEVILS: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pentry. Spray shelves and exposed areas where insects are present. After shelves have dried, place clean paper on the shelves and return items removed from pentry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, AND SPIDERS: Spray as many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room infested with these posts. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove pet's old bedding and destroy or launder. Spray pet's eleeping quarters, bateboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Treat dogs and cats with a registreed flee and tigk Edma'd product before allowing them to enter treated area.

Storage:
