HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage, and  
serving areas. In the home, all food preparation surfaces and utensils

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.  
Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above  
130°F may cause container to burst. Do not apply this water-based  
product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or other  
electrical equipment because of possible shock hazards. Do not use on

READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.  
SHAKE CONTAINER WELL BEFORE USE.  
HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT DURING USE.  
APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, AND GNATS:  
Close all doors and windows. Spray upward with a slow sweeping  
motion into center of room. Spray 5-10 seconds for the average room.  
After application, exit and keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate  
room thoroughly after re-entry. Dispose of dead insects. Repeat as  
necessary.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, AND CRICKETS: Spray as many insects  
as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room  
infested with these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, hidden  
surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas,  
and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Treat doors, around window frames, ant trails, and other  
areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray as many insects as possible. Spray  
both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Thoroughly spray top  
and bottom of rugs and carpets. Treat shelves, closets, areas under  
furniture, and wherever insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as  
necessary.

TO KILL CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES,  
AND RICE WEEVILS: Find and destroy infested packaged goods.  
Remove all other items from pantry. Spray shelves and exposed areas  
where insects are present. After shelves have dried, place clean paper on  
the shelves and return items removed from pantry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, AND SPIDERS: Spray as  
many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room infested  
with these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden  
surfaces under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators. Repeat as  
necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove pet's old bedding and  
destroy or launder. Spray pet's sleeping quarters, baseboards, window  
and door frames, wall cracks, and floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not  
spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried.  
Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before  
allowing them to enter treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place,  
away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at  
temperatures over 130°F.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in  
accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and  
regulations. Reduce pollution at its source.
