TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, AND GNATS:

Close all doors and windows. Spray upward with a slow sweeping motion into center of room. Spray 5-10 seconds for the average room. After application, exit and keep room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate room thoroughly after re-entry. Dispose of dead insects. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS, AND CRICKETS:

Spray as many insects as possible in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room infested with these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Repeat as necessary.
