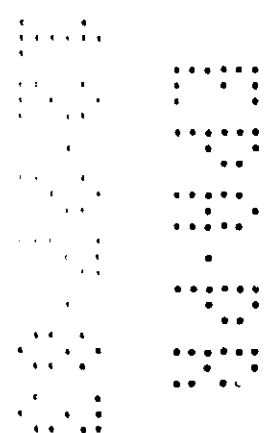

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grained Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard containers in trash.  
Do not incinerate or puncture.

For Use in Rooms, Apartments, Homes, Attics, Basements, Campers, Boats, Household Storage Areas, Garages, Pet Sleeping Areas, Cabins

One Unit Treats up to 5,000 Cubic Feet

Prior to spraying, Cover asphalt tile, waxed floors, waxed furniture, and fabric which may come in contact with the fog (newspapers can be used). Close outside doors and windows, and shut off fans and air conditioners.

FOR BEST RESULTS, open cabinet doors and drawers so that the fog may contact all areas where insects can hide and breed. If flea or tick infestation is suspected, destroy pet's bedding and treat pets with a product registered for animal application.
