The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling:

1. The Statement of Practical Treatment:

> IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Get medical attention. IF IN EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes. physician if irritation persists. IF ON SKIN: Wash off with soap and warm water. medical attention if irritation persists. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and call a physician if effects occur.

- 2. Your application superseded our letter of October 30, 1990. Therefore add a footnote to the label ingredient statement indicating, Contains petroleum distillates.
- 3. Your current Physical/Chemical Hazard statement is acceptable. Please refer to the Agency's proposed new product chemistry guideline and precautionary language for Pesticide Aerosol Flammability in the Federal Register (Vol. 56, No. 34, Wednesday, February 20, 1991) for solicitation of comments.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shot off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

Prior to spraying, cover asphalt tile, wased floors, wased furniture, and fabric which may come in contact with the fog (newspapers can be used).

If flea or tick infestation is suspected, destroy pet's bedding and treat pets with a product registered for animal application.

TO OPERATE VALVE, luck valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve bottom all the way down, booking the catch. Then place forger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under logger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

This product will hill Cockroaches, Ants, Mouseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Sam-toothed Grain Deetles, Rice Neevils, Small Flying Moths, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets, Molt and Fre-adult Fleas.
