The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, NGK R-11, and increasing the amount of another active ingredient is acceptable and a stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
- 2) Submit the corrosion characteristics for this formulation. This information can be noted during the storage stability study.
- 3) Add the statements, "Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause eye irritation.", to the precautionary labeling.
- 4) Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the storage and disposal statement.
- 5) Provide the chemical identity, Chemical Abstract numbers and percent in the mixture for all chemical components of Gividan 7941. Also submit a Material Safety Data Sheet for this ingredient.

Note, the labeling without the deer tick claim has been accepted. If you wish to pursue the deer tick claim you must submit appropriate efficacy data.
