Stop ventilation period of not less than 3 minutes after spraying. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds). Push button to spray. Move arm from side to side in a sweeping motion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VANS, SHIPS AND INLAND AREAS FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

For Use By Department of Defense Personnel Only

To Kill Flying Insects (Mosquitoes, Houseflies and Gnats): Close space 3 feet from any surface, holding dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser spraying aids in dispense only for time indicated. Ten seconds of spraying is 1 cubic foot (10 feet x 10 feet x 10 feet). Keep treated area closed at least 30 minutes before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.
