DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR KILLING FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS: IN-DOORS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Fill room with a mist, keeping about 3 feet away from interior walls, fabrics, furniture and plants. Keep room closed 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary. **OUTDOORS:** When wind is not present, use spray with slow sweeping motion, while standing in center of area. If breeze is present, spray with wind from edge of infested area and let spray drift over desired area. Keep spray about 3 feet from all shrubbery. Do not wet foliage. Frequent reapplication may be necessary to kill additional insects which may drift into the treated area. For wasps, apply in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

FOR KILLING ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting insects directly. Repeat as necessary for control.

FOR KILLING ANTS: Spray trails, hills, around windows and openings around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl, hitting as many as possible.

FOR KILLING BEDBUGS: Spray baseboards, mouldings and floor boards. Spray mattresses, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Repeat spraying at frequent intervals.

FOR KILLING FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings and sleeping quarters for pet. Repeat spraying as often as necessary. Do not spray pets.
