e. Add the following to the Precautionary statements:

Wear clean natural rubber gloves, protective clothing, and goggles, face shield or equivalent. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11.

f. The container disposal statement for aerosol products is "Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
