The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes to your label:

1. The **Precautionary Statement** must be rewritten so that it reads:

Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin or breathing vapors. Wash hands with soap and water after spraying.

2. In accordance with 40 CFR § 156.10 the label for the subject product is required to have a section titled "**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**" that reads:

**If On Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

**If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

**If Swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

A training aid for your own pet.  
Will repel dogs and cats for 12  
to 24 hours when applied daily.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.  
**GENERAL:** For both indoor and outdoor situations, the most effective control for a pet is the sharply spoken word backed up with disciplinary action. This repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to food crops.

**INDOORS:** To break your pet of undesirable habits (such as sleeping on furniture, rugs, and other forbidden areas in your home), spray the article of furniture, rugs, etc., lightly with this product so that the area or object is slightly moistened. Before spraying extensive areas of rugs, fabrics or plastics, test the effect of this product by first treating a small inconspicuous area. This product may stain or soften some fabrics or plastics. An alternate method to avoid possible damage is to spray a piece of cloth lightly and place it on the object or area in your home to be protected. Repeat daily, or as necessary, until undesirable habit is broken.

**OUTDOORS:** To prevent your pet or stray animals from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery or evergreens, lightly spray the edges of flower beds, trunks of trees, base of shrubbery and evergreens, patches of lawn, etc. Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First remove any droppings then spray the spot with this masking odor. To keep stray animals from turning over and upsetting garbage, spray garbage cans and bags liberally when setting out. Reapply as often as necessary until undesirable habits of pets and stray animals are changed.
