DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING Hold container up-right, nozzle away from you and press actuator button, spraying as directed.

To Treat Animals:

To protect cattle from attacks of stable flies, house flies, deer flies, horse flies, horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats: spray about 3 seconds on each side being careful to spray back withers and forelegs thoroughly. To protect from face flies, spray the face and head, but do not spray the eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary.

In Animal Quarrels & Milk Rooms:

For rapid control of house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and small flying moths: close windows and doors and spray at a rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep area closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate after treatment is completed.

In Schools, Hospitals, Institutions, Dairies, Supermarkets, Hotels, Restaurants, Drive-Ins, Motels, Drug Stores and Food Plants: To control: flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, hornets and

small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary. Do not apply while food processing is underway. Food should be removed or covered before treatment.

Cockroaches, Water Bugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Centipedes and Sow Bugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, and cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing. Hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths: Close doors and windows, direct spray into all parts of room, especially around stored food product containers, pallets, and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep areas closed 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application weekly or as needed.

Exposed stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray into cracks, crevices and processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers and all other areas where these insects may tend to congregate. Spray 10 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary.
