### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FLEAS ON DOGS & CATS:** Apply the powder lightly to the hair and down to the skin. Work the powder into the hair and down to the skin. The powder kills fleas by contact when they crawl through it. Sprinkle powder on the bedding of the animals to kill newly-emerged fleas. Repeat application as necessary.

**LICE ON DOGS:** Apply lightly to cover infested areas. Pay particular attention to ears and long hair. Repeat application every ten days or as needed to kill young lice that hatch.

**TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS:** Liberally dust animals with powder on the legs and area between the toes. After application, check for dead ticks.

Do not use on lactating cats and dogs. Do not use on cats or dogs that are still nursing.

**LICE ON POULTRY:** The powder should be well dusted on the birds. The treatment may be applied on the neck, under the wing, or by the pinching method. Pinching should be done on the thighs under the wing and around the vent. Repeat application as necessary.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Avoid breathing dusts. Avoid contact with skin. If swallowed, wash hands after handling. Do not get on water, or food stuffs.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICES**

**IF ON SKIN:** In case of contact, remove clothing immediately and wash skin with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water and consult a physician.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician. Do not use anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
