DIRECTION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with directions. Hold container upright. Press valve down and spray to at least 36 inches to avoid possible staining.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats: Close all doors and windows. Spray at a rate of 1 second per 100 cubic feet to all parts of room, including light sources which attract insects. Hold nozzle in constant motion for 10 to 15 minutes. Repeat treatment as needed.

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Centipedes and Spiders: Close all doors and windows. Spray into all cracks and crevices, under furniture, along baseboards and plumbing, hitting insects as far as possible. Repeat treatment as needed.

Ants: Spray trails; nest. Spray on ants where possible.

Exposed stages of Insects: Grain Moths: Close door and spray into all parts of stored food product containers and enclosed areas. Spray 7 to 10 cubic feet of space. Repeat treatment 10 to 15 minutes following treatment weekly or as needed.

Exposed stages of Flour Mites: Spray into cracks and crevices, under furniture and handling equipment, in attics and other areas where they congregate. Spray 30 to 60 cubic feet. Keep area closed after treatment. Repeat treatment as needed.

Carpet, Bedbugs: Spray baseboards, shelves or other areas as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattress tufts and seams. Take up furniture. Treat baseboards. Allow treated fabric to dry before using. Repeat treatment as needed.

Fleas: Spray sleeping quarters and floor covering where fleas are present. Use only on pets.
