DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.
Use as a spot treatment on localized surface areas only.

TO OPERATE: Holding the can upright, with orifice directed toward surface to be treated.

TO KILL: COCKROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, etc. Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath appliances, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

TO KILL: BROWN DOG TICKS: Apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboard in localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Do not spray pets with this product.

TO CONTROL: FLIES, MOSQUITOES: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in gutters. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will have their effectiveness diminished.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of as hazardous waste.
