

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of ticks, fleas and lice on dogs and cats, dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

For control of ear mites, while dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears.

Do not rinse. Towel Dry. Repeat as necessary.

### DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes. Do not contaminate food or feed stuffs with this concentrate or dip.

### HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Do not treat kittens or puppies less than four weeks of age. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Give 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to unconscious or convulsing person.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get immediate medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note to Physician: Atropine Sulfate is antidotal if eye cholinesterase inhibition are present.

NOTE: Changes in labeling format differing in substance from that accepted in connection with this registration must be submitted to and accepted by the Registration Division prior to use of the label in commerce. 2. Submit the following data or information as soon as possible, but no later than 90 days from the date of this registration.
  - a. Submit an updated revised Confidential Statement of Formula showing the certified limits for all the constituents of this product.
  - b. Submit a chemical information fact sheet for Shell Sol 71, (CAS No. 64741-65-7).
3. If the Agency issues a Notice of Intent to Cancel registration of this product under section 6 of the Act, in significant part because of the risks posed by the presence of Methylene Chloride, the Notice will state that the continued sale and distribution of existing stocks of this product after the date of cancellation will not be permitted. The registration of this product is approved on the condition that you will not request a hearing to challenge such an existing in a Notice of Intent to Cancel.
