PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS/PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing mists. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash hands with soap and water after using.

Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick, old, or debilitated pets. Do not use on nursing puppies or foals under three months of age.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds, streams, tidal marshes, and estuaries. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. wastes.

PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Keep away from heat and open flame.

*PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call physician or Poison Control Center. Give milk or water. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.
If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
If On Skin: Wash off with soap and water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HORSES: Thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. To repel gnats, flies, and mosquitoes, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. Cover entire surface of animal with spray, but avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Brush coat against grain while spraying to ensure adequate penetration of product.

To control STABLE FLIES, HORSE FLIES, DEER FLIES, and FACE FLIES. Apply at the rate of 2 ounces per adult horse, sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment as needed.

DOGS To kill FLEAS, LICE, and TICKS. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired animals, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. For best results, the bedding should be sprayed and then replaced with fresh bedding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and put in trash.
