The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1) Provide the chemical identity, Material Safety Data Sheet and Chemical Abstract Number for D&O 40R 8122. All chemical components must be identified by Chemical Abstract Number and percent in the mixture.
- 2.) In your chemistry data the pH is listed as 6.80 when mixed with water but on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) it is listed as NA. Explain.
- 3.) Since your chemistry data matrix does not give a dielectrical breakdown voltage the statement "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard" must be added to the label directions.
- 4) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.



On long hair hand against the lay of the hair, spray the ruff behind your hand. Make sure the spray thoroughly treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Treat same as cats and dogs puppies and kittens, spray only along back or on and rub into fur.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat results, the bedding should be sprayed and then bedding.

HORSES: to repel Gnats, Flies, and Mosquitoes mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, and Face Flies; of 2 ounces per adult horse, sufficient to wet the Repeat treatment as needed. This product is for horses intended for use as food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place.
DISPOSAL: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
