Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment in the area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Close doors and windows. Point valve down when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free air circulation is not remain in the area during treatment and vent.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position, push valve button all the way down, hooking the catch tab in the center of the room with valve locked. Place newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy old pet bedding. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control.
