The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. For EPA Reg. No. 7056-162, add the following statements under the Directions for Use:

Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The alternate Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is not acceptable. Please provide the chemical identity of all components, Material Safety Data Sheets, CAS Registry Numbers and the percentage or range in percentage in the mixture for the fragrance **Lemon Fragrance #295-7**. Please note that the certified limits but be the same for the basic and alternate formulations. Refer to the last accepted basic CSF and revise accordingly.

With regards to the CSF for EPA Reg. No. 7056-169, although the nominal concentration on the CSF agrees with the label claim, the CSF should be revised by splitting 0.050% for d-cis/trans Allethrin under column 13b as follows: d-cis/trans Allethrin 0.048% and Other Isomers 0.002%. The certified limits should be specified for each under column 14a and 14b.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour
Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small
Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pillbugs, and Crickets.

1. Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, and food-handling
equipment. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and heaters.
Open cupboards, cabinets, and trunks in area to be
treated. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors
and windows.
2. Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or
table in the center of the room. Shake container well
before using. While pointing valve opening AWAY from
face and eyes, press the valve button all the way down,
hooking the catch, and starting the flow of the contents.
3. Carefully place container upright on the stand or table.
LEAVE building at once and keep treated area closed for
four hours.
4. After four hours, open all doors and windows and allow to
ventilate for 30 minutes.

Repeat in two weeks or when necessary. Use one unit for
each 6,000 cubic feet (a room up to the size of 25' x 30'
with 8' ceiling) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for
remote rooms or where the flow of mist is not assured. Use
only one unit per room.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS: Remove pet's old bedding and
destroy or launder. Follow directions above for fogging area.
Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after fogging. Treat dogs
and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before
allowing them to enter the treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Storage: Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry
place, away from heat, sparks, and open flame.
Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.
- Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and
discard in accordance with all local, state, and
federal laws and regulations. Reduce pollution
at its source.
