Dear Mr. York:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
- 2. Make the following changes to your label:
 - a) Per PR Notice 92-2, delete the statements "No CFCs; Contains No CFCs Which Deplete the Ozone Layer" and replace them with the following:

"Contains no CFCs or other ozone depleting substances. Federal regulations prohibit CFC propellents in aerosols."

b) Change the sentences "Use additional units for remote rooms.....in an area less than 100 cubic feet." to the following:

"DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valve). other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e.,

refrigerators, thermostats CANCURRENTE Your gas utility or management company SYMBOL if you needlassistance." EPA Form 1320-1A (1/90) OFFICIAL FILE COPY

c) Change the sentence "Treat dogs and cats with BUGOUT™ FLEA AND TICK SPRAY before allowing them to enter the treated area" to the following:

"Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product such as BUGOUT™ FLEA AND TICK SPRAY before allowing them to enter the treated area."

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving, or storage areas. This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pillbugs, and Crickets.

 Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and heaters. Open cupboards, cabinets, and trunks in area to be treated. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows.

- Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. Shake container well before using. While pointing valve opening AWAY from face and eyes, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch, to start flow of the contents.
- Carefully place container upright on the stand or table. LEAVE building at once and keep treated area closed for four hours.
- 4. After four hours, open all doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes.

Repeat in two weeks or when necessary. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet (a room up to the size of 25' x 30' with 8' ceiling) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the flow of mist is not assured. Use only one unit per room. Do not use this unit in a cabinet or under a counter or table. Do not use this unit in an area less than 100 cubic feet.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS: Remove pet's old bedding and destroy or launder. Follow directions above for fogging area. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after fogging. Treat dogs and cats with BUGOUT™ FLEA AND TICK SPRAY before allowing them to enter the treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage:

Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place, away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130 °F.

Disposal:

Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Reduce pollution at its source.
