

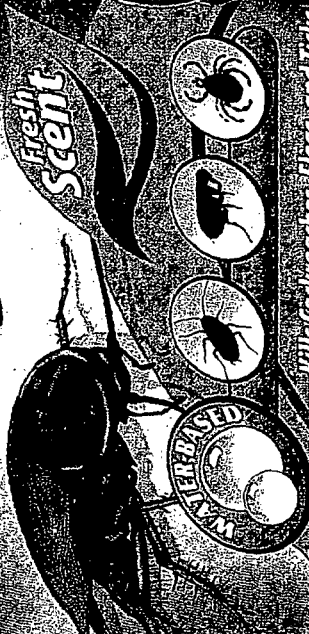

1. Cover or remove exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Shut off fans, air conditioners, and heaters. Open cupboards, cabinets, and trunks in area to be treated. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows.
2. Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. Shake container well before using. While pointing valve opening AWAY from face and eyes, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch, to start flow of the contents.
3. Carefully place container upright on the stand or table. LEAVE building at once and keep treated area closed for four hours.
4. After four hours, open all doors and windows and allow to ventilate for 30 minutes. Repeat in two weeks or when necessary. Use one unit for each unobstructed area. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms.
