To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Use rubber gloves. Work in well ventilated area. Dip animal in solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

This concentrate gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs or cats.

3. This product may be subject to child resistance packaging due to its skin irritation. See the June 11, 1986 Federal Register Notice (54 FR 21276) for more information in this regard. It is the responsibility of the registrant to determine if his product needs to be packaged in child resistant packaging.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
