STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Thoroughly
OR CLOTHING: wash skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center.
IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

FOR DOGS AND CATS: Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Do not spray face, scrotum, or anus. Beginning at the tail, spray body and legs. Fluff the hair so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray coats ticks thoroughly. Repeat as necessary.

For dogs, apply at the rate of two seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short haired dogs and up to eight seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs. For cats, apply at the rate of one second per pound of body weight.

FOR DOG HOUSES AND KENNELS: Remove pet's old bedding and either destroy or launder. Spray interior of dog house, sills, ledges, and outside runways. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried.
