Your October 3, 1996 Submission and April 10, 1997 Letter

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- 1. Delete the second statement beginning "Residually Kills Ants, xxx" from the first column of the labeling, as it is redundant.
- 2. The CFC statement needs to be revised in order to comply with PR Notice 92-2. The statement should be corrected as follows: "Contains no CFCs or other ozone depleting substances. Federal regulations prohibit CFC propellants in aerosols."

The CSF dated December 28, 1993 is acceptable since adequate information on the lemon fragrance 295-7 has been provided. Refer also to our letter dated September 30, 1996.

in the home, cover all food preparation surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling).

TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SOWBUGS, AND CARPET BEETLES: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark comers of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly.

FOR ANTS: Also apply to ant trails, around doors and windows, and wherever these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames; and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and laundered or replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window frames and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, on porches, patios, and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes landing on treated surface will be killed. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage:

Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place, away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130 °F.

Disposal:

Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Reduce pollution at its source.
