5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

CATS AND DOGS: Remove any and insert animal's eyes with hand and with a firm ears and chest until deep. With finger mouth, nose and eyes. Spray neck, middle legs last. For best penetration of spray against the natural lay of the hair. Rub your hand against the lay of the hair, directly behind your hand. Make sure the ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Treat same as cats and puppies and kittens, spray only along back and rub into fur.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around door frames, wall cracks and local areas of gnats or flies are present. Light needed. For best results, the bedding should be replaced with fresh bedding.

HORSES: To repel gnats, flies and mosquitoes mist sufficient to wet the surface of the flies, horse flies, deer flies, and face of two ounces per adult horse, sufficient treatment as needed. This product is not intended for use as food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place and open flame.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container in newspaper and put in trash. Do not contaminate water by storage or disposal.
