#### Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing mist. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash hands with soap and water after using.

#### Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Give milk or water. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HORSES: To repel GNATS, FLIES, and MOSQUITOES, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. To control STABLE FLIES, HORSE FLIES, DEER FLIES and FACE FLIES, apply at the rate of 2 ounces per adult horse, sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment as needed.

DOGS AND CATS: To kill FLEAS, LICE and TICKS, cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears, and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired animals, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Treat same as rats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens, spray only along the animal's back or on your finger tips and rub into animal's fur.

PET SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The bedding should be removed and then replaced with fresh bedding for best results. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended.

STORAGE: Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and put in trash.
