d. Delete the statement "Evercide - Registered trademark of McLaughlin Gormley King Co." since it is not relevant to this product label.

e. Revise the section "To Operate Valve" so that each step appears in the correct order as follows:

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or on table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all door and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

f. The words "Active Ingredients" and "Inert Ingredients" should be aligned to the same margin.

g. Since your data matrix does not provide a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the Physical or Chemical Hazard section:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

3. In reference to the product chemistry data submitted:

a. Provide a complete description of the manufacturing/formulation process. Describe equipment used, mixing time, temperature, pressure, etc.

b. Correct the lower certified limit for tetramethrin from 0.002% to 0.200%, in accordance with the Confidential Statement of Formula and the product label.

c. You must submit a storage stability test on the formulated product. The product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in trade. [Note: For the storage stability data, you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate your product.]

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(3). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling surfaces. Shut off fans and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and pilot lights. Close doors and windows from face when releasing. Use one unit for each unobstructed area. Use additional units for each area if mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area until thoroughly ventilated before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position, press valve button all the way down, hooking standard or table in the center of the room with several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Keep building closed for four hours before allowing windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat if necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding, clean, fresh bedding after treatment in complete premises should be treated with a registered flea and tick treatment and reentering treated premises.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
