ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

For use in and around hotels, motels, homes, greenhouses and lethouses, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, seed houses, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk handling areas of milk, cheese and ice cream plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bekertes, boets, ship cabins and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate rooms for 2 hours before returning patients. Also for use in buses, automobiles, trucks, boxcans and ship cargo holes. Also for use in dog transles and home stables. In home stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

INDOORS

FOR HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS (Miller), FRUIT FLIES AND VINESAR FLIES: Close all doors and windows. Point not requirement, direct the spray mint to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which street these insects. Fill the room with mint, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilets the room when treate and is a completed.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: COCKROACHES (Welerbuge), EARWIGS, GRAIN MITES, SOWBUGS (Ptil buge), SILVERFISH (Firebrate), SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, MILLIPEDES, FLEAS, ANTS, BOOKLICE AND CRICKETS: Spray thoroughly and frequently into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under retrigerators, beseboards, door frames, bookcases and storage

TO KILL ANTS - INCLUDING FIRE ANTS: Spray doors, around window frames, and other points of entiry. Spray ant trails, needs, and hills contacting as many aris directly as possible.

areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO NILL BEDBUGS AND LICE: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices around baseboards, floorboards, bed boards and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may herbor peels, concentrating on tuffs, folds, and seems. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations consult professional applicator.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS, CATS AND PREMISES: Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs, and on other areas except scrotum and anus. Part heir to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about 1 foot (30 cm) away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not apray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment, if necessary. To reduce

station, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting areas until the state is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot (30 cm) at a distance of 12 to 18 inches (30 to 46 cm). Also spray the entire Inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary, thoroughly spraying floors, cracks, crevices and bedding. Hit as many insects directly as possible.

TO PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS: Spray infested African violets, philodendron, begories, geraniums and coleus for control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, spider mites, and fungus gnats. Use with caution. To accertain possible phytotoxicity, apray only a few plants, wait 24 hours, and check for possible injury.

FOR PROTECTION OF WOOLENS: Apply only to germents, blankets, carpets, and other woolen fabrics before placing in storage for protection from larvae of webbing clothing moths and black carpet beetles.

Dry clean or wash garments and blankets before treating. Clean carpsts, draperies and other fabrics by thoroughly brushing before treating.

Hold the container 14 to 18 inches (30 to 46 cm) from the fabric and apply the spray moving eventy in a forward and back motion across the fabric white covering one ,30 cm) per second. Spray the entire fabric surface until it is eligibly moist or damp to the touch. When possible treat both eldes of the fabric. Do not seek or wet fabric. For maximum protection piace treated fabrics offer drying in plastic or paper bags. Also treat cracks and cravices of closets, cheets and trunks where these fabrics are being stored. Treat the cracks and cravices at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot (30 cm). When applied as directed on fabric and in storage areas, this treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection, inspect the fabric in the storage area once every three months. Repeat applications only when necessary. Avoid heavy applications. When possible, make applications outdoors. If application is made

indoors, do not remain in treated ereas. Vertilate the area after treatment is complete.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS: Spray areas infested with mosquitose, gnals (midges), house files, stable files, deer files and flying moths (milers). Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches (46 to 61 cm) from strubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow excepting motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds percubic yard (0.76 cu. m) of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat open porches and paties in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: To control aphids, exposed thrips, adult white flies, leafhoppers, gypey moths, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on smaller modedendrons, plans, spruce, hemicot, spires, dogwood, palm, mimosa, toyan, vibumum, euonymus, calcs, maples, locust, foreythis and althes, and mimosa webworm lerves on mimosa, spray directly on insects. Hold container 18 inches (46 cm) from the infected plants. Spray in short burets of one to three seconds or spray at the rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all eldes covering foliage until alightly moist. Avoid heavy welling. Repeat as recessary to obtain control.

Spray peories, iris, zinnie enapdragons, ageratums, chrysenthemums, nesturtiums,

Spray peories, iris, zinnie enaptingoria, ageratuma, chrysantheniums, naeturitums, daisy, geraniums, margoida, daphne. fatafiedera, ky, tobira, queen asgo end broad leaf acacle for control of aphide, exposed timps, adult whitefies, leafnoppers, plant bugs, aphiliebugs and Japanese bestles. Spray as directed above.

Omemental Quince, Juniper, Cypress, Omemental Mulberry, Ash, Cotonesster, Rose, Camelia, Azales, Pyracenths and Ceenothus may also be treated to control the above peets, but use with extreme caution. Certain varieties have shown some leef burn under certain conditions of use such as heavy dosage. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

TO KILL TENT CATERPILLARS: Application should be made when caterplilars are young and tents are first noticed (usually late spring). For best results, apply in the late altermoon or evening when caterplilars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL GYPSY MOTH CATERPILLARS: Application should be made when caterpillars are young and first noticed (usually tale spring). Spray plants evenly to the point of run-off applying to both sides of leaves and other erees of plants where insects are suspected. For dense evergreens and shrubs, be sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches.

TO CONTROL NUISANCE PESTS: CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES: Same as directed above for indoor Line.

ANTS: Spray trails, neets and points of entry. Spray on antis where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FIRE ANTS: Kills and temporarily reduces annoyance of these insects. To reduce annoyance from these ants and knep tilem from entering homes, spray patios, berbecue areas, driveways, door sits, window sits, other entrance areas, foundations of buildings, ant trails, around pools and areas where the ants are noticed. Spray until the area is wet contacting as many insects as possible. This treatment will not kill the colonies, but will reduce the immediate population for up to four hours. Repeat as necessary. Avoid contacting plants, shrubbery and large areas of lawns.

FLEAS AND TICKS: Same as directed for indoor use.

SPIDERS: (Including black Widow and Brown Recluse): Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

WASPS, HORNET, YELLOW JACKETS AND BEES: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Alm spoul at the nest and deprets justify flegt is encased in foam. This foam prevents the wasps and other peets from flying away. The foam can effectively reach up to 12 feet.
