HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin.
Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or
eyes. Wash hands with soap and water after each use.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation,
storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or
open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container.
Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause
container to burst. Do not apply this water-based product
in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT DURING USE.
APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

For crack and crevice application, attach extension tube to
spray opening. Apply spray in small amounts directly into
cracks and crevices.

TO KILL FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING
MOTHS, AND WASPS: Before spraying, cover or remove
exposed food and utensils. Close all doors and windows.
Spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping
motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for an average size room.
After spraying, exit and keep room closed for 15 minutes.
After 15 minutes, ventilate room thoroughly. Dispose of
fallen insects.

TO KILL ANTS, COCKROACHES, AND CRICKETS: Spray
areas where these pests are found or may hide, including
dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in
walls; along baseboards and door and window frames;
behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and
cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing, and other
utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places
should be sprayed directly. FOR ANTS: Also apply to ant
trails, around doors and windows and wherever these
pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS,
AND SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Find and destroy
infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from
pantry. Spray shelves and exposed areas where insects
are present. Pay special attention to nearby cracks and
crevices. After shelves have dried, place clean paper on
the shelves and return items removed from pantry.
Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CENTIPEDES, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, CARPET BEETLES, AND SPIDERS: Spray as many insects as possible. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room infested with these pests. Pay special attention to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators. **FOR CARPET BEETLES:** Also spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Thoroughly spray top and bottom of rugs and carpets. Treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames; and localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and laundered or replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Storage:** Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place, away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.
- Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Reduce pollution at its source.
