g. Add the following section to the product label.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites.

Point valve opening away from face, aim at nest, depress actuator and continue spraying until nest is soaking wet. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool, dry place away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Do not incinerate or puncture. Reduce pollution at its source.
