Point valve opening away from face, aim at nest, depress actuator and continue spraying until nest is soaking wet. Repeat as necessary.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL •

STORAGE:

Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool, of the place away from heat, sparing, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.
