COMBUSTIBLE: Avoid storing or using near open flame. (Flash point approximately 104 degrees Fahrenheit Red Label not required.)

AMSCO AGRISOLV #1 is effective in the control of seedlings of such weeds as Johnson Grass. Pig Weed, Annual Morning-Glory, Barnyard Grass, Nut Grass, Foxtail, Brachiaria, Goose Grass and Crabgrass.

Annual broadleaf plants with larger medium seeds such as Cocklebur, Purslane, Milkweed, and Nightshade, may require repeated application.

RECOMMENDED USAGE:

COTTON: When cotton is 7 to 10 days old and at least 3" high, post-emergence directed spray for weed control may be started at the rate of about 5 gallons per acre, not more often than at five day intervals. A total of three such applications should be sufficient, but do not make more than 5 applications. Examine cotton plants carefully several days after application. In the event of scars or other minor damage discontinue spraying

After true bark (stem cracking) is observed discontinue use completely.

SOYBEANS: A directed spray between the 12th and 14th day of growth. Use only one application, 5 gallons per acre. Use same equipment as for cotton. For more information on both uses see our brochure covering uses in detail.
