AMSCO AGRISOLV #3E is an aromatic emulsifiable herbicide. Applied as an emulsion to submerged aquatic weeds, it is effective in the control of white water crowfoot, waterweed, horned pond weed, leafy pond weed, sago pond weed, Richardson pond weed, gigantic sago, American pond weed, water star grass and arrowhead. Such emulsions are also effective in control of filamentuous algae.

RECOMMENDED USAGE:

Aqueous emulsions of AMSCO AGRISOLV #3E are prepared by blending AMSCO AGRISOLV #3E into a suitable amount of water. The resultant emulsion is introduced into flowing water in such quantities as required to produce the concentrations of AMSCO AGRISOLV #3E noted. Stirring or other agitation is required during blending to produce a uniform emulsion.

Introduce emulsion below the water surface with spray nozzles. Best results are obtained with pressures of about 100# per square inch. Optimum results may be expected when water temperatures are 70 degrees Fahrenheit or above.

FLOWING WATER: Apply to result in a concentration of 8 to 10 gallons per cubic foot second (600 to 740 ppm) of AMSCO AGRISOLV #3E when introduced over a period of 30 minutes. Optimum results may be expected at water flow velocities of 0.75 to 1.25 feet per second.

Consult local agricultural agents for concentration calculations.

After use, clean equipment with water.

Water may be applied to crops or consumed by livestock after emulsion blanket has disappeared.
