Your Letter Dated June 21, 1991

Your submission of storage and stability data and revised basic product labels for the subject product has completed review. The comments below apply.

The storage and stability data are acceptable.

The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, with the following comments.

1. The removal of the plasticizer, Dimethyl Phthalate, from the active ingredients to the inert ingredients in this formulation is acceptable.
2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable.
3. The 30-day 50°C storage and stability data indicate that the product degrades 30% in active ingredient. The label should, therefore, have an expiration date or be over-formulated to the equivalent of the percent loss during a one year period.
4. It is preferred by the Agency that the Human Hazard Signal Word (Caution) appear below "Keep Out of Reach of Children". The signal word reflects a toxicity category and not an advisory against possible danger to children. You must remove the colon after the signal word.

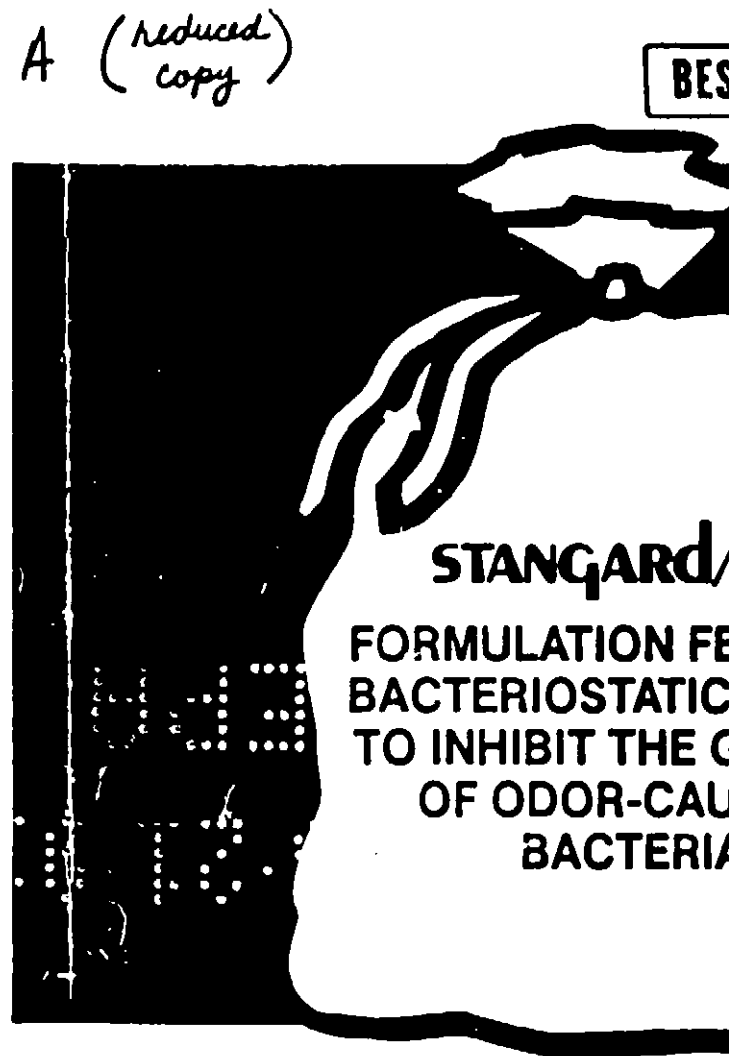
