DISINFECTION: To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops), use 1-1/2 ounces (1 packet) per 3 gallons of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer. Wet thoroughly. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes, then let air dry.

For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

SANITIZATION: To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, use 1-1/2 ounces (1 packet) per 7.5 gallons of water. A POTABLE WATER RINSE is required at this level. Apply with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer. Wet thoroughly for at least 60 seconds. Rinse thoroughly. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

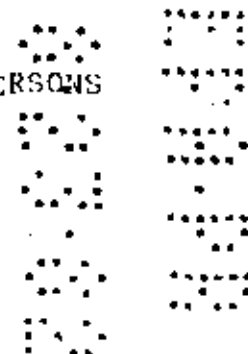

DANGER

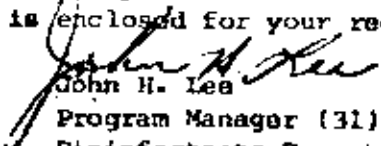

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned hard non-porous surfaces, use 1-1/2 ounces (1 packet) per 3 gallons of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer. Wet thoroughly, let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.
