1. Submit and/or file all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 7109-6."
 - b. There are indications that 3-Iodo-2-Propynyl Butyl Carbamate is phytotoxic. Delete the recommendations for use in flat beds, coldframes, and greenhouses unless it can be shown that such use will not injure plants.
 - c. Delete the statement "No sealers are necessary on frequent contact surfaces." Labeling for the 3-Iodo-2-Propynyl Butyl Carbamate you used includes the statement "Surfaces which may be in continuous contact with skin should be coated with a varnish or lacquer after treatment." This statement should be included on your label.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

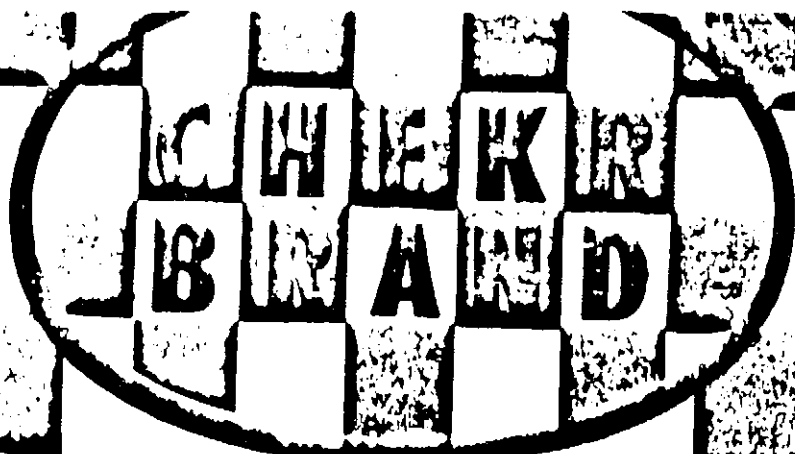

COMBUSTIBLE: Do not use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame. In case of fire, use water spray, foam, carbon dioxide or dry chemical.

CHEKR BRAND CLEAR WOOD PRESERVATIVE

Chekr Brand Clear Wood Preservative contains 3-Iodo-2 Propynyl Butyl Carbamate which controls Mildew, Algae, Blue Stain and Woodrot. It also contains water repellents which inhibit water penetration to prevent warping and splitting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for exterior use only and is recommended for shingles (not asbestos), shakes, rough-cut cedar, clapboards, smooth or rough-cut wood siding, decks, porches, railings, shutters, outdoor furniture, structural support timbers, flat beds, cold frames and greenhouses. No sealers are necessary for frequent contact surfaces. The product is not recommended for wood used for ground, food, feed or potable water. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to avoid possible injury. This product can be used where dairy and farm animals may come in contact with the treated wood.

Chekr Brand Clear Wood Preservative may be used on wood surfaces that have been previously treated with stain. DO NOT USE on a painted or sealed surface. This would stop penetration and reduce the effectiveness of the product. Chekr Brand Clear Wood Preservative is PAINTABLE. Allow 24 hours drying time before the application of stains or paint.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

NEW WOOD - Surface to be treated must be clean and dry. Apply at 200 - 400 square feet per gallon depending on porosity of surface. Chekr Brand Clear Wood Preservative may be applied with a brush, roller, or spray. A generous coat should be applied to insure penetration into the wood.

OLD WOOD - Unprotected old wood is usually various shades of gray to black. This is due to mildew and ultraviolet light attack on the wood surface. Remove mildew discoloration by washing thoroughly with a solution of household bleach and water mixed in equal amounts. Rinse thoroughly and allow a minimum of 24 hours drying before applying Clear Wood Preservative. Surface must be totally dry to touch before application. Old previously stained wood should be treated the same as old wood.

SPECIFICATIONS

Drying Time: 6 to 8 hours. Allow 24 hours before applying stain or paint. Drying time is affected by ventilation, temperature and humidity.

Coverage: 200 to 400 square feet per gallon. Coverage varies with surface texture.

Thinning & Clean-Up: Paint Thinner

Number of Coats: One on most surfaces. Two coats are recommended on severe exposures.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not expose this product to excessive heat.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
