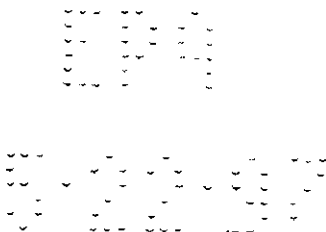

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Fabric to be treated should be completely dry and brushed free of dirt and dust. Laundering or cleaning with soap and water is not recommended as it will cause shrinkage and may also impair the effectiveness of the coating.

Thoroughly stir contents and mix with an equal volume of petroleum solvent complying with Rule 66. Approximately one gallon of the diluted preservative coating is sufficient to cover 10 square yards of fabric surface. Apply to dry fabric with a stiff brush or spray gun using a coarse spray followed by brushing with additional solvent if necessary. Use only out-of-doors or in a well ventilated place. Allow to dry thoroughly before folding or storing.

STORAGE

Keep containers dry.
(Store between 0° F - 115° F.)
Do not store near heat, sparks, flame or strong oxidants.
