LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING MACHINE OR AUTOMATIC WASHER:
4 SOAKING SUDS:—Add 1 tablespoon of this product to each 2 gals. water. Mix well. Add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry 11 m. to overnight. Wash. Rinse.

IN WASHING SUDS—Add 1 tat. spoon of it to product for each 2 gals. water. Mix well. Add suds to detergent. Immerse laundry. Wash. Rinse. (For automatic washers into which laundry is placed before water is added, dilute recommended amount of this product in 1 gal. of water, and pour into washer after laundry is immersed.)

BLEACH, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER OR CLEANSER:
To remove STAINS—Fruit Berry Wine Coffee Tea Chocolate Vegetable Flower Grass. Blood and many ink dyes and food stains, also SCORCH and MILDREW (Do not use on silk, wool or fast colors)—Make solution of 1 tablespoon of this product for each qt. cold water. M. thoroughly. Immerse fabric 5 to 15 min. Rinse well in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Any trace of mildew remaining usually disappears when fabric is dried in sunlight.
