

GUARDIAN Heptachlor for control of Household Insects
CAUTION: Heptachlor should be applied only as spot treatments in the home. Do not use this product as a space spray.
GUARDIAN HEPTACHLOR EMULSIFIABLE (2 lb. per gallon) should be diluted with water, 1 part 9901 EMULSIFIABLE HEPTACHLOR to 48 parts of water for a 0.5% Solution.
FOR THE CONTROL OF ROACHES AND WATERBUGS, thoroughly treat infested cracks and other hiding places and of adjacent exposed surfaces where roaches and waterbugs will crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat application when necessary.
FOR THE CONTROL OF ANTS, thoroughly treat ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where they enter. Also, treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come into rooms from wall spaces or partitions. Repeat application when necessary.
FOR THE CONTROL OF CARPET BEETLES, thoroughly treat infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors and baseboards and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Repeat application as often as necessary to maintain effective control.
FOR THE CONTROL OF FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND WASPS, thoroughly treat around selected surfaces such as doors, around windows and areas frequented by these pests. Also thoroughly treat screens, window frames, door sills, and selected areas of porches, where these insects tend to alight or congregate. Repeat application when necessary.
FOR CONTROL OF BOXELDER BEES, thoroughly treat around door sills, window frames or wherever these pests may enter the house.
FOR CONTROL OF CRICKETS, thoroughly treat baseboards, floors of closets and storage places and other hiding places. Repeat application when necessary.
FOR CONTROL OF SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES thoroughly treat infested areas in basements. Repeat application when necessary.

DIRECTIONS

Add 2½ gallons of GUARDIAN HEPTACHLOR 2E (2 lbs. actual Heptachlor) to 120 gallons of water (0.5% emulsion). Apply the 0.5% emulsion as follows:

(1) SLAB-TYPE CONSTRUCTION

(A) Apply 1 gallon per 10 square feet as an overall pre-construction treatment under the slab and along attached porches or entrance platforms.

(B) Apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet to critical areas under the slab as preconstruction treatment, such as along the inside of the foundation walls and around utility entrances and interior partition foundation walls.

(2) BUILDING WITH CRAWL SPACES

(A) Apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet in a trench along the outside of foundation walls, including entrance platforms and porches where the foundation is not more than 15-18 inches deep. If over 15-18 inches deep but not over 30 inches, apply 4 gallons per 5 linear feet. Do not go deeper than the top of the footing.

(B) Apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet as a trenching application to critical areas under the house, such as along the inside of foundation walls and around piers and utility entrances. If trench is deeper than 15-18 inches but not over 30 inches, apply 4 gallons per 5 linear feet. Do not go deeper than the top of the footing.

(C) Apply 1 gallon per 10 square feet of soil surface as a pre-construction treating where the attached porches, entrance platforms, utility entrances, etc. have covering slab on fill of ground.

(D) Apply 1 gallon per 5 linear feet of wall to voids in hollow masonry units of the foundation.

(3) BUILDINGS WITH BASEMENTS

(A) Apply 1 gallon per 10 square feet as an overall pre-construction treatment under the basement flooring, attached porches, entrance platforms, utility entrances, and similar situations where slab fill is at ground level.

(B) Apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet in a trench along the outside of foundation walls, including entrance platforms and porches where the foundation is not more than 15-18 inches deep. If over 15-18 inches deep but not over 30 inches, apply 4 gallons per 5 linear feet. Do not go deeper than the top of the footing.

(C) Apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet as a trenching application to critical areas under the house, such as along the inside of foundation walls, porches, entrances and piers. If trench is deeper than 15-18 inches but not over 30 inches, apply 4 gallons per 5 linear feet. Do not go deeper than the top of the footing.

(D) Treat all voids in hollow masonry units of the foundation at the rate of 1 gallon per 5 linear feet of wall. Premises treated with 0.5% HEPTACHLOR will give residual control for a minimum of five years.
