

**DIRECTIONS
FOR INDOOR USE ONLY**

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE DOSAGE SHOULD BE LIMITED TO 3.25 OUNCES PER AVERAGE ROOM. This material must be applied by or under the supervision of Trained Personnel.

GERMAN ROACHES: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil and use one pint of this diluted material to every 500 square feet or 5000 cubic feet of air space. Spray all areas frequented by roaches. Spray all cracks, crevices, around baseboards, sinks and cabinets.

FLEAS: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil and use one pint to 500 square feet. Spray cracks, crevices, baseboards, couches, stools, on the underside of chairs, bed frames and paying special attention to coil springs, bed posts, if hollow. Treat floors and floor coverings. Treat fabrics lightly to ascertain whether damage will occur. Make spot test in closets or in out of way places. Thorough application is desirable. Treat mattresses on underneath side only, around seams and rolls. Dog and cat bedding may be treated on underside to kill fleas, but beddings should be ventilated 12 hours before use.

FLIES: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use one gallon of diluted material per 4000 square feet. Spray walls and ceilings. Remove livestock before spraying.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint per 500 square feet. Kennels, sheds and other areas not occupied by humans, which are infested with brown dog ticks must be thoroughly treated with the diluted solution. Remove all animals before spraying. Apply to cracks, doors, and window frames, floors and walls. Spray the floor and floor coverings.

ANTS: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint to 45 linear feet. Thoroughly treat ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where the pests may enter the premises. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat treatment as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

SILVERFISH: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint to 500 square feet. Thoroughly treat baseboards, areas behind shelving, bookcases and storage areas and other infested cracks or hiding places.

SPIDERS: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint to 500 square feet. Apply as wet spray along infested baseboards and corners. In basements, treat pipes, storage localities and other areas infested. Repeat treatment where necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Dilute 1 to 19 with water or oil. Use 1 pint to 500 square feet. Apply to localized areas of the floor, baseboards and closet shelves and work the material into cracks and under carpets where the insects may be found. Treat underside of infested carpeting.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: Dilute 1 to 19 with water and oil. Use 1 pint to 500 square feet. For reducing the fly and mosquito population that may enter the dwelling, apply by brushing or as a coarse, wet spray to selected outside portions of residence. Use around windows, doors, and screens. Apply to walls and ceilings or porches and in outbuildings.

DI-Ron: A new development to produce a residual and kill of adult fleas, roaches, flies and ticks.

DI-Ron: Contains a volatile chemical compound which evaporates or fumes slowly into the air. It controls insects by a new method similar to a gas. It has vaporizing action as well as direct contact action and still provides a residual effect. The amount of the vaporized insecticide in the air at any one time will depend upon the air currents, humidity and temperature. Surface absorption occurs on many objects, but re-volatilization continues dispersing the active ingredient.

DI-Ron is a combination of organic phosphates and should be applied with care. Be sure and follow directions for use.

Avoid undue exposure to the fumes. Care should be taken not to overdose.

When **DI-Ron** is diluted 1 to 19 with water or oil, one pint of this diluted material is sufficient to treat 5000 cubic feet or 500 square feet.

Exposed food should be removed. All dishes should be covered. A low pressure applicator should be used. A thin stream for cracks and crevices from an oil can makes a good application.

Since **DI-Ron** forms a crystal surface it remains constantly active.

DANGER

Do Not Get In Eyes, On Skin, Or Clothing. Do Not Breathe Fumes. Do Not Store Near Feed Or Food Products. Do Not Allow Children And Pets To Contact Treated Areas Until Surfaces Are Dry.

POISONOUS if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed, give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep warm and quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. If on the skin, wash with large amounts of soap and water. If inhaled, remove the victim to fresh air. Keep warm and quiet. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. Atropine sulfate is an antidote. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

DANGER

Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for DDVP protection. Wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles when handling the concentrate or preparing diluted solutions. Keep all unprotected persons out of the operational areas. Do not swallow, avoid prolonged exposure.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME

VOLATILE COMPOUND

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
