

**NOTICE**

Zinc Phosphide is a dark gray powder, insoluble in water and has the formula  $Zn_3P_2$ . It deteriorates rapidly when exposed to moisture or acids. As fats and oils increase the absorption in the body, bait of this material must be kept dry for best results.

**DIRECTIONS**

Place baited teaspoon piles of bait at 8 to 10 foot intervals where mice and rats feed, water or travel. Bait must be placed in locations not accessible to children, dogs and domestic animals or wildlife or in tamper proof bait boxes. Boxes must be made of wood or metal, tamper proof and with baffled entrances. Baiting rodents along walls in corners, and in concealed places where rats and mice can feed unobserved are preferred. Do not destroy uneaten baits after 72 hours. Do not treat the same area with Zinc Phosphide in less than 30 days.

**CAUTION**

KEEP THIS PRODUCT CONTAINER WASH THOROUGHLY AFTER EACH USE. ALWAYS WEAR GLOVES WHEN HANDLING. DO NOT USE THIS CONTAINER FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE. Do not use foods which will be attractive to children, such as cookies, candy, nuts, etc. Do not use on plants with skin.

**DIRECTIONS**

When making Rat and Mouse bait with Zinc Phosphide and used with no other bait it will remain toxic for a longer period of time as will baited out lines. Bait must be placed in a dry, away from the busy mouse tunnels.

BAIT SHOULD BE PLACED IN AREAS INACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS, WILDLIFE AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. DO NOT TAMPER WITH BAIT BOXES. NOT FOR USE OR STORAGE IN OR AROUND THE HOME.

**ANTIDOTE**

GIVE ONE TABLETS OF MUSTARD IN A GLASS OF WARM WATER. REPEAT UNTIL VOMITING IS CLEAR. ALSO GIVE ALL OILS AND FATS WITH A FLUORANT. IMMEDIATELY CALL A PHYSICIAN.
