- c) An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days.

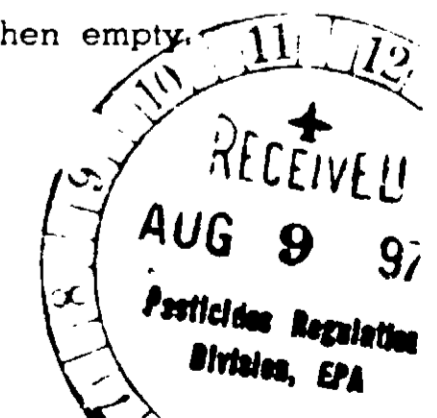
