

DIRECTIONS

ROACHES AND WATERBUGS: Use as is in any good sprayer that will apply a coarse fan pattern to areas to be treated. Apply to all cracks and crevices where roaches might hide. Spray around window sills, sinks, pipes, cupboards, etc. The residual action should provide protection for approximately 3 to 4 weeks on adults and for the young that hatch out in this interim period. Allow approximately 10 to 12 days for good results. Repeat applications of the spray as necessary.

ANTS: Apply as for roaches, making sure to treat all cracks in masonry where ants might get back to the soil or dampness. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

BROWN DOG TICKS: For household use, spray around cracks and crevices. For animal sleeping quarters, spray cracks and crevices on walls and floors, with this solution, using about 200 milligrams per square foot. This is to point or run-off. A fan type spray should be used for this application. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES: Apply same as for Roaches.

SPIDERS: Spray the infested area with 202. Immediate control of the adult can be had when sprayed directly to the web. Control of the infant will be by the residual properties. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

SILVERFISH: For control of silverfish thorough spraying of baseboards, areas behind shelving, bookcases and storage areas. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective results.

CARPET BEETLES: Spraying of infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors and baseboards, and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Localized treatments of areas on floors, baseboards and shelves of closets. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective results.

CRICKETS: Thorough spray of baseboards, floors of closets and storage places and other living places. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective results.

202 INSECTICIDE may be brushed on surfaces where spray method is impractical, such as floor moldings, window sills, waterpipes, and wherever natural insect runways are apparent.

For Professional Trade

202 INSECTICIDE requires no special equipment for application. Regular pressure sprayers with coarse-spray nozzle is adequate. For application in inaccessible areas, use pressure sprayer with pin-stream nozzle. Avoid careless application when working around food or food handling establishments since this is a toxic material.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

CAUTION: Should not be used on or near foodstuffs. Do not contaminate foods. Toxic, can be absorbed into skin. Wash hands with soap and warm water after each use. Remove clothing if contaminated.
