Directions for Use

Dilute with water to the following percentages to be used for the different types of work enumerated below:

WHAT IS

FOR FOGGING: 1 part Pyrethrin No.6600 to 19 parts of water.

FOR SPACE AND CONTACT SPRAYING: 1 part Pyrethrin No. 6600 to 9 parts water.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS:
Close doors and windows, directing the spray up toward the ceiling. The room should be filled with mist and remain closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up dead insetts and burn. Repeat treatment as necessary. The frequent spraying of breeding places also helps. DO NOT REMAIN IN TREATED AREAS. VENTILATE THE AREA AFTER TREATMENT IS COMPLETED.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS AND SILVERFISH Spray liberally with force around refrigerators, sinks, all cabinets around pantry shelves, winto all cracks and crevices in moulding and woodwork, pipeopenings in walls and floors, or wherever these insects might hide. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Use the spray so as to wet as many insects as possible paying particular attention to nests or runways. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Bedsteads should be sprayed thoroughly in all corners, cracks, and crevices. Sprwings and mattresses should be sprayed thoroughly after the bed has been dismantled, spraying tufts and seams in the mattress. Spray loose mouldings, cracks and crevicesw.

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES:

Special care should be given to be sure
all cracks and openings- below the baseboards are thoroughly wetted with spray.
Clothes when aired should be sprayed at
a distance of 3 to 4 feet taking care to
see that seams and folds are wetted.
Closets should be sprayed at least twice
a month, directing the spray on the garments
