Before using Ava-Tac, brush all dirt, dust or accumulated droppings from the roosting area.

Ava-Tac, will remain tacky for a long period of time, to enhance its repellency. It will not run in direct sunlight, and will remain tacky to 100°. Be sure to apply only where needed.

Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Because of the petroleum solvents, Ava-Tac does have an odor. Do not Use Near Fire or Flazes. Do Not Smoke while applying.

Directions

Ava-Tac is a non-lethal repellent to be used for nuisance bird control. Ava-Tac will not kill, it only repels by making the roosting area uncomfortable for the starlings, feral pigeons and sparrows.

Ava-Tac, should be applied with a sprayer or beading gun to the roosting area. Be sure to treat the ridge line, gutters, downspouts, chimneys, window ledges and other areas where the birds pre-roost or roost. Apply a bead approximately 1/2" wide and approximately 1/2" thick.

Ava-Tac can be used on trees, poles, fences, feeding boxes and other areas where birds frequent.

CAUTION

Ava-Tac has a tacky base material and will be sticky and to be kept from areas where spilled or dropped, as a petroleum solvent to dissolve or remove it.
