



**DIRECTIONS**

Place several self-feeding stations in locations frequented by rats and mice. Continuous feeding from 10 to 15 days should give control. Replace empty stations within 24 hours. Bait should be available to rats and mice until complete lack of feeding is noticed. Sour or otherwise decomposed bait should be replaced immediately. Place close to walls or corners where rats and mice can feed unobserved.

**FOR MICE:** Use at least two self-feeding stations in the areas where mice are known to exist. Use stations not more than 10 feet apart. Bait must be replaced daily to 10 days.

**FOR RATS:** Use at least two self-feeding stations in the areas where rats are known to exist. Bait must be replaced daily to 10 days.
